

Installation Instructions
ZZP Rear Sway Bar
Gen 2 Chevy Cruze



Estimated Installation Time: 1 Hour

**Installation Difficulty: 2/5** 

## **Kit Contents:**

- ZZP Rear Sway Bar
- 2 Nut Mounting Plates
- 4 Bolts

# **Tools Needed:**

- Socket set
- Ratchet
- Electric Drill
- Drill Bits




### STEP ONE:

• Set nut plates on top of the rear beam spring seat and align rear nut with the existing hole in the rear beam.

## **STEP TWO:**

- Install sway bar using only the rear mounting bolts.
- Make sure the bar is aligned with the pocket in the rear beam and is not contacting the rear beam.





## STEP THREE:

 With the rear bolts tightened, mark or center punch the rear beam for the front mounting holes of the sway bar.

### **STEP FOUR:**

- You may choose to leave the bar in place or remove it after marking the holes.
- You can use some blue tape to protect the bar from the drill bit.





### STEP FIVE:

- Drill the center of your marks up to 7/16" or 1/2" drill size.
- Remove the sway bar and clean the holes.
- Paint the bare metal to protect from rust.

## **STEP SIX:**

- Install the sway bar using the 4 provided bolts.
- Install all 4 bolts finger tight before tightening fully.



## **STEP SEVEN:**

- The bar should be aligned with the rear beam. Make sure there is no contact between the sway bar and the rear beam.
